# Monterey Vista Elementary School Uniform Policy and Dress Code

Students at Monterey Vista are encouraged and expected to wear school uniforms where possible. For those students who are not able to, it is necessary that they abide and follow the dress code.

Students from Kindergarten to 6<sup>th</sup> Grade at Monterey Vista School should comply with the following dress guidelines:

- 1. Shoes must be worn at all times. Slippers, flip flops, crocs, and backless shoes or sandals are not acceptable.
- 2. Clothing shall be free of writing, pictures or any other insignia which are crude, vulgar, profane or sexually suggestive or which advocate racial, ethnic, or religious prejudices or the use of drugs or alcohol.
- 3. Clothing shall be sufficient to conceal undergarments at all times.
- 4. Pants shall be appropriate size and not too baggy or excessively large.
- 5. Hats and caps and other head coverings shall not be worn indoors. They may be worn outdoors for the purpose of protection from the sun.

The school's uniform policy are as follows:

## FOR TOPS

Collared polo shirts in white, light blue, or dark navy blue Collared t-shirts/blouses in white, light blue or dark blue School Spirit/Grade Level T-shirts of all colors are acceptable

## FOR BOTTOMS/PANTS

Pants and shorts (Bermuda short) should be blue, solid navy blue and include khaki color. For skirts/skorts, the color should also be blue, navy blue and khaki color as well. They can be pleated or non-pleated.

## BELTS

They must be sized to fit with non-hanging ends. Solid metal buckles are not acceptable.

## **OUTERWEAR**

Jackets, sweatshirts, and sweaters should not contain any inappropriate messages, logos and graphics.

The main purpose of the school uniform policy/dress code is to promote the best interests and safety of all students. This helps the school to ensure that each child is in an environment that is conducive to learning.
